Note: Teach using whole words. Words are the minimal unit conveying a complete conceptual meaning. Meaning is what we're all after. It's the main reason we have language - to convey & receive ideas (concepts) & thoughts.

That doesn't mean it's never useful to deconstruct a word, (sometimes called word attack) or build a word from scratch, or notice how words work together. Of course this can be useful. Many words and meanings are too long, too many or too complex to grasp just by

seeing or hearing whole words, even repeatedly.

Many common small words of English have taken on lots of meanings, often very different from each other. (Think of some meanings for the small word 'set'). Using context doesn't always nail it. Relying on pictures is too random.

To say, or accurately hear, a single spoken word requires skills from 4 **Prep Step Kits**: vocabulary, speech sounds, blending of speech sounds, skill at dividing into syllables (syllabification sə'lab'ə'fə'kā'shən), pronunciation, stress & intonation!
